Sunday 17 th October	21.00 22.00 approx	French group arrives from Dieppe at Newhaven. Arrival at Dorothy Stringer (Surrenden Road /Draxmont Way) to be met by families.
Monday 18 th October	08.45 11.00 15.15 approx	Stringer pupils bring French partners to school and take them to D tree. <u>French pupils should be provided with a packed lunch.</u> Enterprise activities in school periods 1 & 2 (French students only) with Mr Harkin - computer room D11 + classroom F3. French students walk into town for town trail, followed by visit to Royal Pavilion 1.00 pm. Return to school by bus. Arrive back at school (D tree), to be met by partners.
Tuesday 19 th October	08.45 09.00 10.00 15.15	Stringer pupils bring French partners to school and take them to D tree. <u>French pupils should be provided with a packed lunch.</u> Group walk to Surrenden Rd for coach pickup. Visit to Drusillas with exchange partners (including Enterprise workshop) Arrive back at school (D tree).
Wednesday 20 th October	08.45 9.00 12.30 approx 15.15	Stringer pupils bring French pupils to school and take them to D tree. <u>French pupils should be provided with a packed lunch.</u> French group take bus to town for shopping in Brighton town centre. Visit to Sealife Centre. Return to school by bus. Arrive back at school (D tree), to be met by partners.
Thursday 21 st October	08.45 09.00 13.00 15.30 approx	Stringer pupils bring French pupils to school and take them to D tree. <u>French pupils should be provided with a packed lunch.</u> French group takes coach to Seaford beach for walk along cliffs to Cuckmere Haven. Coach picks up from Seaford Head car park and takes group to Bowlplex (approx 13.30 pm). Collected by Stringer minibus. Stringer pupils meet French partners at D tree.
Friday 22 nd October	07.00	Stringer families bring partners to Surrenden Road outside Varndean Sixth Form College to take coach to Newhaven for return ferry journey (09.30) to Dieppe. <u>French pupils should be provided with a packed lunch.</u>
